How to buy a ticket

1. You must have a valid ticket because you can't buy tickets on trains.
2. You can use Travelcards and Capitalcards but check that they cover the right zones.
3. If you have already bought a Docklands ticket put it in the Validation Column before going through to the trains.
4. If you haven't got a Ticket or Card, then you need to buy a ticket. Please follow these rules.

1. Buy a ticket

How to buy a ticket:

- Press the 'Ticket Type' button for either an Adult or Child fare.
- Look up your destination on one of the lists – i.e. for Docklands Light Railway, London Underground or British Rail stations.
Make a note of the number shown next to your destination.
- Press this number on the Destination panel.
- The price of your ticket will flash up on the display panel.
- Put in the necessary coins, remembering that the machines give change.



2. Validate it

- Take your ticket from the machine and place it in the Validation Column, this will time and date your ticket.

If the machines are not working, see the Train Captain when you get on the train.

WARNING: You must have a valid ticket before you travel. If you do not pay the fare for the full journey you may be liable to pay an additional fare of up to £10.
