

DOCKLANDS LIGHT RAIL All stations are designed for maximum visibility.

All stations and trains are regularly patrolled by Officers, Sometimes in plain clothes.



The Docklands Light Railway is patrolled by a dedicated section of the British Transport Police. It is their responsibility to maintain and improve safety and security, and to help enhance the quality of life for the passengers and staff who are the Docklands community.

> Each of the Officers is made specifically responsible for a small number of stations. In this way they become familiar to both passengers and staff.

On board every train there is a uniformed DLR member of staff.

OCKLANDS

Every year Police deal with about 55 items that have been left on the Docklands Light Railway. Please keep your luggage with you at all times.



Docklands Light Railway staff receive training on all aspects of passenger safety and security.

> The Railway is monitored by CCTV.

They patrol the trains regularly, from the first early morning to the last late evening trains. Sometimes patrolling Officers are in plain clothes. They know their own patch and their presence serves to deter crime.

Extra support is always available on an area or system wide level, but an Officer on the Docklands Light Railway is in an ideal position to judge when extra police presence would be required and why.

The officers can only continue to fight crime with the help of you, the passenger.
