Seltrac – one of the world's most advanced train control systems now operates systemwide.







Seltrac, our new train control system, has now been introduced across the whole DLR network. This highly sophisticated system, one of the most advanced in the world, will enable us to introduce many service enhancements for the benefit of our passengers.

From July 29th, we will be running an additional service between Bank – Crossharbour on Saturdays (currently Tower Gateway – Island Gardens and Stratford – Canary Wharf) connecting DLR with London Underground in the city.

We've also got great news for Beckton passengers. On July 31st we will be introducing a through service from Beckton to Tower Gateway which will make getting to and from the City much easier. This service will operate from 05.30 to 00.30hrs, Monday to Friday.

In the autumn, we plan to improve the frequency of weekday services between Stratford – Canary Wharf and, as passenger demand continues to grow, between Bank – Island Gardens, making commuter journeys more comfortable.

Weekend services between Poplar - Beckton will be introduced later in the year.

Additional features.

- The Seltrac system provides a new safety feature in the form of emergency train stop buttons. These are located on every platform and will stop a train in the event of an emergency.
- For your information, please note that with the Seltrac system, doors start to close as soon as the warbler sounds.
- The new dot matrix Passenger Information Displays will show the next three train destinations and estimated waiting times as well as providing improved passenger information.
